

LURING

The appearance of having a reward in hand (i.e. holding the thumb and first two fingers together) as if holding a treat. No treat need be present. Handler will be given a substantial deduction of 6-10 pts.

NO!

This is not part of your vocabulary when training dogs. Neither is any *grunting* by you in disgust.

This word should not be uttered during a training session. It's easy to get caught up in what your dog may not do right, but is it your dog's fault??? Probably not, or your dog just needs a break. Your dog will react to your grunts. Better to just calmly repeat what you were doing, or take a break? You need to figure out what went wrong.

OUT OF POSITION

An example of "out of position" is when a dog is forging, lagging or wide that is equal or greater than a 1-point deduction in Obedience.

PAUSE SIGNS

Some signs have you pause after going around your dog. It is an IP if you do not pause on these signs: #s30, 31, 35, 105, 203, 204

Some signs have you pause for other reasons. It is also an IP if you do not pause at these signs: #s 118, 306, 307, 322
