New Master Exercises: 302, 309, 312, 322

Tips:

302. HALT - Recall over Jump- Finish- Left Turn- Fwd — AKC Video: https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=4ddxbN68EDg You'll Halt at the sign, leave your dog, and go to the other side of the jump. Make sure you can see your dog between the stanchions before calling him to front to help him not go around the jump. There is a finish-forward. You may finish the dog in either direction. This is a left turn on the course map. You are facing the dog and will actually be going to your right.

309. Backup 3 Steps - Right Backup 1 or 2 Steps - Forward - AKC Video: https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=mHtUIze-Dz4
An easy way to remember which way you will be turning after walking backwards at least 3 steps is to stick out your right arm (in this case) and go in that direction. It's saying "right' backup".

312. Dog Spins Right - Fwd - AKC Video Version 1: https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=W1HjrBSi5V4

The dog will spin to the right in this exercise. Try not to move your feet after the halt until the dog is finished with the spin. It can be a bit challenging with the dog spinning towards you.

322. Stand - Leave 2 Steps - Call to Heel - AKC Video: https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=sKyeqxilcOI

This is the same as Advanced sign #118, except your dog will stand (not sit) when you stop. Make sure your dog does not anticipate your command for him to heel. You should occasionally reward for staying and repeat it. Don't let them ever have an opportunity to anticipate by not doing this.
